FAQ (frequently asked questions)

How do I get a ticket?

Details of how to purchase tickets will be announced by the BBC at a later date. As in previous years, tickets for this event will be geographically weighted with the majority share going to Dundee residents.

How do I get to Camperdown?

A shuttle bus facility from elsewhere in Dundee will be organised and ticketholders will be strongly encouraged to use this to get to and from the event. How easy is it to get to Dundee?

You can fly direct to Dundee from London City, Belfast and Shetland, or choose an international airport - Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Glasgow.
